Dear Parent

Leavers should return uniforms to Mr Simpson immediately after this event. **Junior School Sports** will take place on Friday 13th June, **Senior School Sports** on Friday 20th and **Junior Start Sports** on Monday 23rd.

In order to support the forthcoming HPV Immunisation campaign, **NHS Glasgow** has requested details of our pupils' names, addresses and ages for their new school database. We would propose to accede to this request unless you have any objections.

A few reminders: **The School Shop** will cease trading at the end of term with Man's World becoming sole suppliers thereafter (note **the Second Hand Uniform Sale** in School on Saturday 7th June); **sensible parking please at Balgray** – I have had complaints from residents in Leicester Avenue about cars parked across driveways with engines running: both illegal!
