Junior pupils follow the early grade examination syllabus. They are offered options including Poetry, Drama, Sight Reading and Theory of Speech.

Senior Speech & Drama

Senior pupils learn all aspects of the junior class in more detail and also cover English literature. Those studying Grade VI and upwards are prepared for Diploma standard.

Public Speaking

These lessons include prepared and impromptu speeches, presentation skills and the art of reading aloud. Seniors may take medals in this subject.

Group Discussion, reading, verse speaking and acting are all available in class and in preparation for external examinations.
